Thank you to everyone that responded to our survey and to everyone who reached out through emails and other platforms to share their thoughts with us. We’re so happy to hear that so many of you enjoyed this year’s event, and we’ve also listened closely to the concerns that some participants raised.

We acknowledge that several external factors impacted the event’s delivery, including baggage collection, adverse weather conditions, the Holdfast Bays Council’s Jetty Road redevelopment, and the temporary suspension of tram services. These circumstances required us to make a number of operational adjustments to ensure the event could proceed as smoothly as possible such as changing the route temporarily which unfortunately caused unexpected congestion at the finish line.

We are implementing revised arrangements in 2026 to ensure an even smoother experience for all participants. We truly appreciate your continued support.

Fun Facts from City-Bay 2025 □

In 2025:

- **13,706 females and 13,334 males** joined the fun this year - that’s a whole lot of City-Bay legends!
- **10,331 teams** took on the challenge together - teamwork really does make the dream work.
- **The 12km** was a crowd favourite, with 17,539 of you running, walking, and wheeling your way to the finish line.
- Our **youngest participant was just 2 years old, while our oldest, aged 90**, completed the 12km in 2 hours 15 minutes, proving that City-Bay is truly for everyone!
- The City-Bay community **raised over \$520,000** for charity!
 - **Top Charity by Total Raised:** Childhood Cancer Association – \$50,684

- **Top Individual Fundraiser:** Run for Olly – \$16,368 for the Neurosurgical Research Foundation
- **Top Fundraising Team:** Pembroke School – \$21,460 for Canteen
- **Lee Morgan** completed his 50th City-Bay, while **Tony Heard** and **Gil McIntosh** each finished their 51st run – making them the most seasoned City-Bay participants ever.
- All City-Bay 2025 participants combined ran, walked, and wheeled a whopping **295,172 km** – that’s more than 7 times around the Earth!
